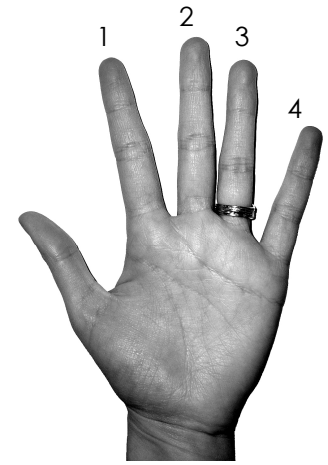


# Violin Fingering Chart: First Position
